Start at white line at entrance to un-metalled road (Rake Head Road) approximately 0.6 mile west of Holme Village and 130 yard west of bridge on the A6024

Continue in a westward direction for 1.3 miles

To finish opposite sign "Welcome to Holme Valley in Kirklees" sign Altitude 524m (1719 ft)

Distance (1.3 miles)

Ascent – 655 feet climb

### Headquarters

Holme Guide cottage Situated at the side of A6024, west of Holme Village.

### Parking

Parking is restricted in the village; please do not inconvenience the residents. There is adequate parking either, on the road leading to Holme Junior School, last years HQ or in the lane running down to Digley reservoir. **No warming up on the course after the start of the event. Please have a rear light available we had to restrict one event due to poor visibility.**
