### Cyclo cross news:-

Amira Mellor was 3rd U14 girl in the 6th round of the National Trophy at Bradford - her best position so far and despite the chain slipping! She has not ridden all the rounds [only 4 of 6 so far) but is lying 6th U14 girl at the moment. The National Championships are in January at Derby so she is training hard for that.

In the Yorkshire series she has been 1st girl U14 in every race she has done. Due to early season committments she is 2 races down on some girls putting her in 3rd U14 girl overall at the moment with 2 races to go. There are 7 out of 9 to count so she is working hard to achieve a successful outcome once again. She has really enjoyed riding in the National Trophy races, each one different and very challenging (not just the courses but also the weather conditions, having ridden in snow, ice and 'wheel deep' mud). Richard Binks V40 is 5<sup>th</sup> overall at the moment despite being one race down on the top 3 placings so hopefully Richard will achieve a good Top 3 position with 2 races to go. Rachael Mellor 'having a go' is joint 1<sup>st</sup> V40 lady but this is purely down to lack of numbers! She says, "These are the first races I have enjoyed so much despite being really useless at it. The atmosphere is great and it makes the competition secondary" Other riders taking part are Steve Rimmer in the V40's, Jack and Thomas Ford in the U12's and below, Felicity Gledhill and Sophie Williams.
